Winter Series Dual Sprint 2010

Supplementary Regulations – Part 1

1. **ANNOUNCEMENT AND JURISDICTION:** The Winter Dual Sprint Series is organised by the Taupo Car Club Incorporated. The meetings are held under the National Sporting Code of MotorSport New Zealand Incorporated, Current Manual or Manual No 34 and any relevant Appendices and Schedules relating thereto. The meetings will be organised under MotorSport New Zealand Permit numbers: **T.B.A.**

4. **ENTRY FEES:** The entry fees are : **Dual Sprints: \$95.00 (including GST) Includes Transponder**
5. **The VENUE:** Is the Taupo Motor Racing Circuit located on the corner of Broadlands Rd and Centennial Dr.

7. **CLOSING DATES FOR ENTRIES:**

8. **ENTRY CRITERIA:** Acceptance of entries will be at the organiser's discretion. They must be on the official entry form accompanied by the appropriate fee. Closing dates will be enforced and late entries will only be accepted at the organiser's discretion accompanied by an additional entry fee of \$30.00. Entries will be processed on a first come first entered basis. **A Max. limit of 80 entries.** Dual entries (1 car and 2 drivers) will be accepted at the organiser's discretion.
9. **ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES:** Will **NOT** be sent out.
10. **LICENCE REQUIREMENTS:** All dual sprint competitors must hold a minimum of a ClubSport competition licence. Day licences can be purchased from the Motorsport New Zealand Steward on the day.
11. **CLASS REQUIREMENTS:**

DUAL SPRINTS: This class is primarily intended as an entry-level event for novice and inexperienced competitors.

A minimum of 6 cars will be on the circuit at any one time. Over driving or aggressive driving will result in exclusion from the event. Competitors will be grouped fastest to slowest based on their lap times on the day. One practice and three races Time permitting.

12.CIRCUIT SPRINT (Multi Car)

Grids of up to 6 cars may be started. Minimum of Clubsport Licence. Driver must have competed in 2 dual sprint races on the day. Cars grided fastest to slowest. Up to 4 laps of circuit. These will be run after Dual sprints, time permitting.

13 SERIES POINTS SYSTEM:

Dual Sprint competitors - will be awarded points based on their own improvement in performance, lap times, through out the individual rounds of the series. By this we mean that we intend to reward driving performance and not necessarily vehicle performance improvements. 20 points will be awarded for the greatest improvement on the day in a descending order to 18th place being awarded 2 points. 1 point for all other cars.

14.VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS:

All competing vehicles and competitor safety equipment must comply conform to the requirements laid down in Motor Sport New Zealand Manual No 34, Schedule A. Failure to comply with these requirements will result in exclusion from the meeting. **SLICKS ALLOWED**

15.DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING:

Will be conducted at the Taupo Motor Sport Park. From 8.00 - 8.45am for Dual Sprint competitors. Please note that all cars that do not have a logbook will be scrutineered at each event.

16. DRIVERS BRIEFING

will be held for Dual Sprint competitors at 9.00am sharp. Attendance is compulsory for all competitors.

17. CANCELLATION / ABANDONMENT:

The organisers reserve the right to postpone or abandon the event in part or in full in the case of force Majura with consultation with Motorsport New Zealand and/or the appointed Stewards. The organisers further reserve the right to cancel the event if less than 40 entries are received by the stated close of entry dates listed above.

18. BBQ:

We will host a BBQ for all competitors and helpers at the lunch break of racing. The organisers invite all competitors and their family and friends to attend. The Bar will be open at completion of racing.

19. RESULTS:

Will be available throughout the day. Series results will be posted at the next event, in the club magazine and on the club web site as soon as practical after the event.
