I've been given some information that has come from the latest MSNZ scrutineers newsletter, there has been an issue brought up with regards to people mounting "go pro" style cameras on their helmets, this is not allowed as "helmets may not be modified except as specifically permitted by helmet manufacturer" and MSNZ are not aware of any manufacturer that authorise this. Schedule A currently doesn't specifically cover the mounting of cameras although it does cover security of mounting. An addition of a clause covering camera mounting is in the process of being written.

Also there will be a scrutineers training session at the clubrooms on October 3rd, everyone who is interested in helping out with scrutineering is welcome to attend. Please see the attached form to register your interest

WAIKATO NATIONAL TRIAL - We need your help!



Date: Saturday 12-11-2016

We are looking for 50 adults to Marshall hazards on the day of our trial in November. There will be 15 Hazards in the morning and 15 Hazards in the afternoon with 3-4 Marshalls per Hazard.

A donation of \$40 per Marshall will be paid to your club. Lunch and water will be provided.

Marshalling at these events is a chance to see the action up close while assisting with the running of the event. But we do need to people to commit to showing up on the day and attending training beforehand so the day runs smoothly for everyone.

The event will be held on farmland off Karakariki Rd off SH25 just out of Hamilton. This location is widely remembered by many for holding a number of successful trials 12+ years ago.

About the Four Wheel Drive National Trial Series:

The National Four Wheel Drive Trials Series consists of six rounds held between Labour Weekend and Easter each year. Each round is run by a local Four Wheel Drive club of the NZFWDA.

Teams of two, a driver and navigator, attempt each hazard, being scored on the distance they get, rather than the time they take. The aim is for a perfect score of Zero. At the end of the day, the lowest score over the 30 hazards wins. 4x4 Trials are great spectator events, with lots of mud, noisy engines and rollovers. It's a sport of finesse and precision and is a true test of man and machine.

We have initial interest for _____ Marshalls to assist on the day and will provide finalised numbers by 1st October.
